Course Registration Fee

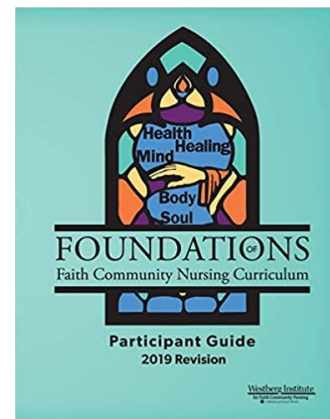
\$350.00 includes class materials. Fees and registration due by September 10th *Non-refundable charge of \$100 will be made for cancellations.

All class hours must be attended and course assignments completed to receive contact hours and completion certificate.

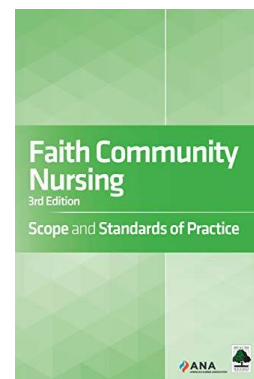
